Vinrock is a small family owned Wine company, with 29 hectares of Vineyard at Willunga, 6 km South of McLaren Vale

These were planted in 1998, the Vinrock wines, first released in 2004, have won numerous awards and were made by Scott Rawlinson.

The Grenache variety is well suited to McLaren Vale, producing soft, full and savoury wines with high alcohol and a With a generous middle palate. Grenache is a major component of the Southern Cote du Rhone wines in France and the Rioja wines of Spain

Winemakers tasting notes:

Deep purple wine with rich, sweet aromas and plum and red berry flavours.

Intense and rich on the palate with well integrated oak giving great balance and finish.

A great food match with both Asian and modern Australian cuisine, drink 2009-2012.
