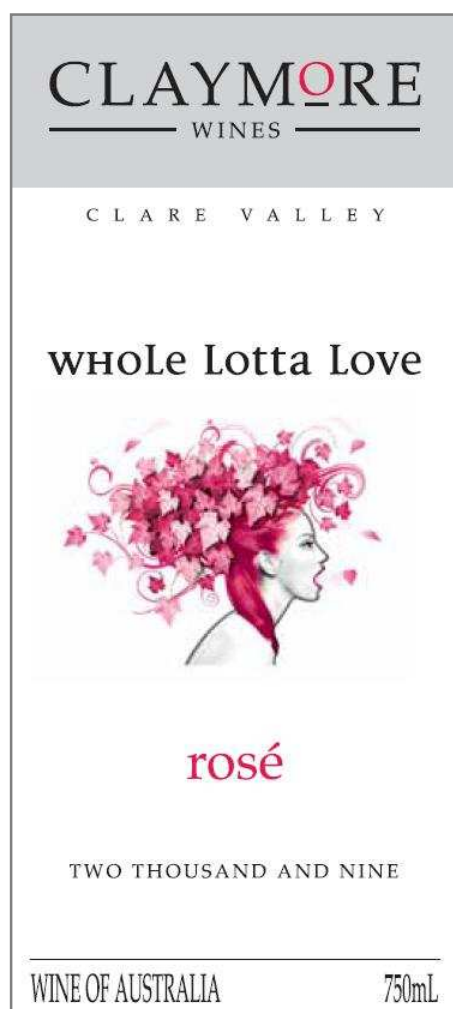

2009 Whole Lotta Love Rosé

Gone is any sense of déjà vu – now we usher in the age of love...

A portion of our Clare Valley Grenache is hand harvested a little earlier in the season to make this refreshing Rosé wine. Fermentation and storage in stainless steel produces a light bodied wine with vibrant primary fruit characters.



WINEMAKER	Dave Mavor
GRAPE VARIETIES	91% Grenache 9% Shiraz
REGION	100% Clare Valley
COLOUR	Electric raspberry red / pink.
BOUQUET	A lifted nose of rose petal, Turkish delight and cherry lollies balanced by a pleasantly herbaceous, almost soft spearmint character.
PALATE	Again carrying just 'on threshold' sugar, the palate is juicy and voluptuous without obvious, sugary sweetness. Confectionary and rose petals mingle with musk and cherry fruits and that subtle herbaceous note continues in the mouth with a fresh, clean finish.
GENERAL	Sufficient colour is extracted from a prolonged (36 hour) cold soak prior to fermentation and the pressings fraction is kept separate from the Rosé base, producing a fine wine without bitterness or drying tannins.
SERVE	A delicious brunch / light lunch wine – chilled to perfection with smoked salmon and chive scrambled eggs. Start your day off right!
